SSC did not fully understand results at previous SSC, so it was re-addressed at this SSC meeting

Remember last king mackerel assessment used data through 2012. The only new information is the subsequent catches and subsequent projections using those catches

SEFSC was asked to provide candidate revisions to the yield streams based on the premise that the actual catches in the years 2013 and 2014 were less than what was projected for those years

But that premise was incorrect. The original OFL and ABC projections assumed that the 2012 catches would occur in 2013 and 2014. But the actual catches were 26% HIGHER than in 2012 (on average). The original reference points and the updated reference points are in the table. Note that the updates does not mean an updated assessment. Rather it means that the projections were updated to accommodate the request that was made by the Council of the SSC

Therefore, the SSC affirmed that the king mackerel OFL and ABC for 2017-2019 be as they were gioven in the two left hand columns and that these be the basis of future management actions
