
### Significant cases continued

### Miss Ruby then Recreational Boat

- Miss Ruby Longlining with 807 hooks (only 750 allowed)
- No reef fish permit and no longline endorsement.
- NOVA issued
- Recreational boat with hidden grouper filets

- Feb.- Longline vessel using reef fish as bait
- Feb.- Recreational vessel in possession of Gag Grouper during closed season
- Mar.- Charter captain running charters without proper USCG credentials

- April-Longline vessel using King Mackerel as bait
- April-Charter captain running charters without proper USCG credentials


