- Focus: EFH science, management, and integration into EBFM.
- Participants: <100
 - Councils (~5 per Council from leadership, staff, Habitat/SSC Committee members)
 - NMFS (leadership, HQ, Regional Offices, and Science Centers)

Terms of Reference


- Assess current state of habitat science and identify major data gaps that should be addressed at the national level.
- Identify successful approaches to EFH identification and review.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of actions taken to minimize adverse effects of fishing on EFH.
- Identify opportunities to integrate habitat information into the fishery management process and EBFM.
- 5. Identify opportunities to ensure effective communication and coordination between NMFS and councils on non-fishing impacts.


Outcomes:

- Shared information and approaches across regions/ Councils and between scientists and managers to inform EFH 5 year reviews and other management actions.
- Opportunities and best practices to overcome challenges to improve habitat conservation efforts.
- Publish Summit outcomes in a report or a special issue of a journal.
