Gulf Council Motions Report October 20-23, 2014 Mobile, Alabama

Joint Administrative & Budget/Personnel

Motion: Have staff submit to NOAA activities to be funded and carried over to the 2015 budget extension request.

Motion carried.

Motion: To give staff & the Council Chair the authority to decide on projects to fund in 2015 with 2014 carryover funds, if indeed this decision needs to be made by the end of this year. If additional time is provided, then staff and the Council will make the decision.

Motion carried.

Motion: That there be a one-time increase in the liaison funding to the Gulf States and the GSMFC for up to an additional \$20,000 for each entity.

Motion carried.

Motion: To do away with the eastern-western geographical descriptions under the AP Panels. Motion carried.

Motion: To make Option 1, "Discontinue the SSC Conflict of Interest Policy," the preferred policy. Motion carried.

Joint LEC/Law Enforcement

Motion: To instruct staff to create a document that eliminates the requirement to carry decals for vessels with charter vessel /headboat permits.

Motion carried.

Motion: To retain option 2: "Modify the current charter vessel and headboat definitions in 50 CFR 622.2 by adding the following words "or provides goods or services" after who pays a fee throughout the definition as outlined in the background material. In addition, add a definition of for-hire fishing in the Gulf of Mexico exclusive economic zone to clarify if vessels accept goods or services in exchange for fishing trips they must have a valid federal charter vessel/headboat permit and valid U.S. Coast Guard Captain's License on board the vessel" as the preferred alternative.

Substitute Motion:

To retain option 2: "Modify the current charter vessel and headboat definitions in 50 CFR 622.2 by adding the following words "or provides goods or services" after who pays a fee throughout the definition as outlined in the background material. In addition, add a definition of for-hire fishing in the Gulf of Mexico exclusive economic zone to clarify if vessels accept goods or services in exchange for fishing trips they must have a valid federal charter vessel/headboat permit," as the preferred alternative.

Substitute Motion failed.

Substitute Motion: To adopt status quo, no action, as the preferred alternative.

Substitute Motion carried.

Motion: To commend the LDWF for their ongoing efforts to solve the need for the transport within Louisiana state waters of multi-day on the water bag limits at Port Eads Marina as outlined in their NOI as amended. Motion carried.

Motion: Fund the LEAP state representative to attend Gulf Council meetings in their respective state. Motion carried.

Motion: To ask the Council staff to work with the GSMFC staff to develop an officer or team of the year program for the GOM.

Motion carried.

Motion: To accept the State's committee operation plan. Motion carried.

Mackerel

Motion: To select Preferred Alternative 4: Establish a trip limit of 3,500 lbs for the Southern Zone. When 75% of adjusted Southern Zone quota is met or projected to be met, the trip limit would be reduced to 1,500 lbs. When 100% of adjusted Southern Zone quota is met or projected to be met, the trip limit is reduced to 500 lbs until the end of the fishing year or until the Southern Zone commercial quota is met or projected to be met, at which time the commercial sector in the Southern Zone would be closed to harvest of Spanish mackerel. *75% of the current adjusted Southern Zone quota = 1,692,848 lbs *100% of the current adjusted Southern Zone quota = 2,257,130 lbs, be the preferred alternative.

Motion carried.

Motion: That Framework Amendment 2 be submitted to the Secretary of Commerce for implementation and that the regulations be deemed as necessary and appropriate, and that staff be given editorial license to make the necessary changes in the document. The Council Chair is given the authority to deem any changes to the codified text as necessary and appropriate.

Reef Fish Amendment 39 - Regional Management of Red Snapper

Motion: To add an Alternative 4 in Action 1, Regional Management: To establish a regional management program in which the regions submit proposals to NMFS describing the conservation equivalent measures each region will adopt for the management of its portion of the red snapper quota.

Motion carried.

Motion: That in Action 1 Alternative 2, add an Option c that would allow delegation to sunset after 2 calendar years of the program, and an Option d that would allow delegation to sunset after 3 calendar years of the program. In Action 1, select Alternative 2 Option d (delegation with a sunset after 3 calendar years) as the preferred alternative.

Motion carried.

Substitute Motion: That in Action 1 in Alternatives 2 and 4, add an Option c that would allow regional management to sunset after 2 calendar years of the program, and an Option d that would allow delegation to sunset after 3 calendar years of the program. In Action 1, select Alternative 2 Option d (delegation with a sunset after 3 calendar years) as the preferred alternative. Substitute Motion withdrawn.

Motion: That in Action 1 in Alternative 4, add the same sunset provisions that are in Alternative 2. Motion carried.

Motion: That under Action 3, apportion the recreational red snapper allocation as shown in Table 2.3.5. Select as preferred: Alternative 2 Option d, and Alternative 3, Options a and b.

Motion Withdrawn.

Motion: That in Amend 40- new action, the preferred sunset option be the 3-year option (b). Motion carried 12-5.

Substitute Motion: That the preferred option be the 5-year option. Substitute Motion failed 8-9.

Motion: Instruct staff to include the following in the appropriate place in the document -To establish a moratorium on the creation of inter-sector trading of IFQ shares and an Individual Fishing Quota program in the charter for-hire sector.

Substitute Motion: Instruct staff to include the following in the appropriate place in the document: That Amendment 40 does not mandate inter-sector trading or the development of an IFQ program for the charter for-hire sector.
